

Qatar boasts a rich traditional culture that deeply values family, hospitality, and its historical heritage. Men traditionally wear the "thobe," a long white garment, while women wear the "abaya," a black cloak. Traditional Qatari cuisine includes dishes like "machboos," a spicy rice dish with meat or fish, and "luqaimat," sweet dumplings often served during Ramadan.

Festivals play a crucial role in Qatari culture. National Day on December 18th celebrates Qatar's independence with parades, fireworks, and cultural events. Another significant festival is Garangao, celebrated by children during Ramadan, where they sing traditional songs and collect sweets and nuts from neighbors.

Music and dance are integral to Qatari traditions. Instruments like the "oud" (a stringed instrument) and "darbuka" (a drum) are commonly used. Traditional dances such as the "ardah," performed with swords, showcase the country's heritage.

Falconry, the sport of hunting with falcons, is a cherished tradition passed down through generations. Additionally, traditional boat racing, using dhows (wooden sailing boats), remains a popular sport reflecting Qatar's maritime history.

Qataris also take pride in their craftsmanship, creating intricate textiles, pottery, and jewelry. The Souq Waqif, a traditional market in Doha, offers a glimpse into Qatari culture with its stalls selling spices, garments, and handicrafts.
