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LES NOTES : RÉSUMÉ DE LA LEÇON 5

- Les Saisons (The Seasons):
 - Le printemps (Spring), L'été (Summer), L'automne (Autumn), L'hiver (Winter).
- Les Couleurs (Colours):
 - Rule: Colours usually come after the noun.
 - Agreement: They must match the gender of the noun. Add -e for feminine and -s for plural.
 - Example: Un sac bleu (m) / Une voiture bleue (f).
- Être vs. Avoir:
 - Être (To be): Used for identity, emotions, and location. (I am happy).
 - Avoir (To have): Used for possessions and age. (I have 12 years).
- Verb Endings (Present Tense): To conjugate, remove the ending (-er, -ir, -re) and add the following:
 - -ER Group: -e, -es, -e, -ons, -ez, -ent. (Ex: Parler)
 - -IR Group: -is, -is, -it, -issons, -issez, -issent. (Ex: Finir)
 - -RE Group: -s, -s, ---, -ons, -ez, -ent. (Ex: Vendre)
