

1607 : Jamestown : the first English settlement was founded in America (Virginia)

color religion, or national origin.

2009:

Rosa Parks **REFUSED** to give up her seat to a white passenger in a bus. A bus boycott **BEGAN**. Segregation **WAS OUTLAWED** in buses.

Martin Luther King **delivered** his famous speech "I have a Dream" during a massive demonstration in Washington D.C.

First African slaves **arrived** in Virginia

Barack Obama **became** President.

Racial segregation. Homer Plessy **was arrested** for refusing to leave the seat he was sat on on a train wagon reserved to white people. The supreme court then **adopted** the slogan « separate but equal » which **legalized** racial segregation.

Birth of Martin Luther King

Civil war **began** : the North and the South fight over the issue of slavery

Ruby Bridges **went** to a school formerly reserved to white students.

Billie Holiday **sang** "Strange Fruits" which **choked** the American society.

He **issued** the Emancipation Proclamation, declaring that « all persons held as slaves » within the Confederate states « are, and henceforward shall be free ».
