Alexander Graham Bell

Graham Bell was born on March 3, 1847 in Edinburgh, Scotland. Alexander Graham Bell was an inventor and a teacher of the deaf. He is famous for creating one of the world's most important communication devices—the telephone.

In the 1870s, Bell began working on the telephone with Thomas Watson. On March 10, 1876, Bell made the first successful test of the telephone. In 1877 Bell established the Bell Telephone Company.

Alexander Graham Bell died on August 2, 1922. At the time of his burial, every telephone of the Bell system in the United States and Canada was kept silent for one minute.
