★ Verb + WILL (Future Tense) ★

Let's Learn!

We use **will + verb** to talk about the future.
(Future = something that happens later.)

✓ Positive:

I will play.
She will go.

✗ Negative:

We use **will not (won't) + verb**.
I will not (won't) play.
He will not (won't) eat.

? Question:

We start with **Will**.
Will you play?
Will she come?

Time Words for the Future:

Tonight
Tomorrow
Next week

Example:
I will visit my grandma **tomorrow**.
