Planet Earth is the third rock from the sun and the only known planet in our solar system. Unlike any other planet we know, Earth provides the perfect conditions for life to exist. From the hot deserts to the icy poles, Earth is home to diverse range of habitats, each full of unique life forms.

These life forms can be broadly divided into two groups: flora and fauna. Flora refers to all the plant life on Earth, from the tall trees in the rainforest to the very small algae floating in the oceans. Fauna, on the other hand, includes all the animal life, from the majestic lions roaming the grassland to the microscopic insects hidden in the soil.

All these plants and animals are **interconnected** in a complex web called the food chain. Plants, using sunlight and nutrients, produce their own food.
