Tense	Formula	Example
Simple Present	am / is / are + past participle	<i>The sauce IS MADE with vinegar.</i>
Simple Past	was / were + past participle	<i>Anna WAS SENT to the festival.</i>
Present Continuous	am / is / are + being + past participle	<i>The battle IS BEING HELD today.</i>
Present Perfect	has / have + been + past participle	<i>The recipe HAS BEEN KEPT secret for years.</i>
Modal	modal + be + past participle	<i>The sauce CAN BE TASTED at the event.</i>
