

We use the Past Perfect for actions that happened at a specific time in the past.

*I had seen the poster.*

*She hadn't acted before.*

*Had they read the rules? Yes, they had./No, they hadn't.*

### Past Perfect and Past Simple

We use these tenses to show that one event happened before another.

We link the Past Simple and Past Perfect with *because*, *before*, *by the time*, *when* and *after*.

*By the time his friends arrived, Jim had tidied up his bedroom.*

*Abe rang Carla after he'd spoken to Bea.*
