### Present simple questions

We can ask <sup>1</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ questions, or add a <sup>2</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ like *what, how, who, where* or *when* to ask for extra information.

We form questions:

- with the verb <sup>3</sup> \_\_\_\_\_: *Is this the right classroom? Where **are** the showers?*
- with a form of <sup>4</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ or a modal verb: *Does lunch start at one o'clock? What time **do** we get up? Where **can** I get a room key?*
