

Present Perfect Continuous

Grammar Summary

1 Form

have/has + been + verb-ing	
✓ POSITIVE	✗ NEGATIVE
I/you/we/they have been working he/she/it has been working	I/you/we/they haven't been working he/she/it hasn't been working
? QUESTION	? HOW LONG
Have I/you/we/they been working ? Has he/she/it been working ?	How long have you been working ?

2 When do we use it?

USE	EXAMPLE
Action still in progress	<i>She has been studying for three hours. (She is still studying now.)</i>
Repeated action up to now	<i>He has been playing football since he was six.</i>
Action just finished (with visible result)	<i>I 've been running. That's why I'm out of breath.</i>

3 Time expressions

Word	Meaning	Example
for	a period of time	<i>for two hours / for ages</i>
since	a point in time	<i>since Monday / since 2018</i>
how long	question about duration	<i>How long have you been waiting?</i>
recently / lately	'in the last few days/weeks'	<i>I haven't been sleeping well lately.</i>

4 Watch out!

We do NOT use present simple or present continuous here:

✗ *We wait here for twenty minutes.*

✗ *We're waiting here for twenty minutes.*

✓ *We've **been waiting** here for twenty minutes.*

Embedded Questions

Grammar Reference

Embedded questions are questions hidden inside a sentence. In embedded questions, the word order is **statement word order** (subject + verb), NOT question word order.

They often begin with: *I don't know ...*, *I wonder ...*, *Can you tell me ...*, *I have no idea ...*, *I'm not sure ...*, *Do you know ...*

Question Where is the nearest pharmacy?

Embedded question *I don't know where the nearest pharmacy is.*

Question How long does the flight take?

Embedded question *I have no idea how long the flight takes.*

⚠ Remember!

- **Direct question:** *What time does the museum close?*
- **Embedded question:** *Do you know what time the museum closes?*
