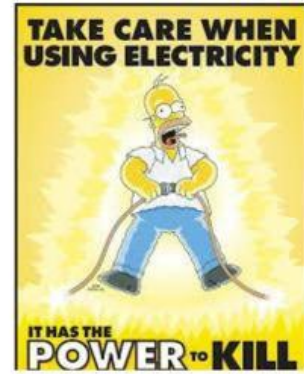

"The mechanic is repairing a car right now."
