



## Different Types of Schools

<p><b><u>Adult Education</u></b>            These schools teach adults basic skills like reading, writing, math, science and English. The students can improve their skills to get a better job or to earn a high school diploma.</p>	<p><b><u>Colleges and Universities</u></b>            These schools offer courses so a student can earn a bachelor, masters or doctoral degree in a specific area of interest. Colleges and universities prepare students for careers and students earn a degree. Students applying to a college will have their high school diploma or equivalent.</p>
<p><b><u>Community College</u></b>            Community colleges offer two year associate degree programs. The programs can be academic, vocational or technical. Community colleges offer students a more reasonable cost than many colleges. Credits from your courses can be transferred to a college of university.</p>	<p><b><u>Technical or Trade Schools</u></b>            Technical or trade schools can be private businesses or part of a public technical school program. They help you earn a certificate or license. These programs specialize in job related skills such a computer technician, electrician, auto mechanics, medical office staffing and more.</p>
