Experiment
/ɪk'sper.ɪ.mən/ (n)

The physical parts of a computer or machine that you can touch (example: screen, keyboard, wires, sensors).

Devices /dɪ'vaɪ.sɪz/
(n)

A special room or place with tools and machines for doing scientific tests and experiments.

Laboratory
/lə'bɒr.ə.tər.i/ (n)

Programs and instructions that tell the hardware what to do (example: apps, Windows, games). It is not physical sensors).

Hardware

A test done to discover something new, check an idea, or prove a fact.

Software /'sɒft.wer/

Tools or small machines made to do a special job (example: phone, sensor, thermometer).
