'It's a piece of the sky!' says the big boy. 'Look! Another one!'

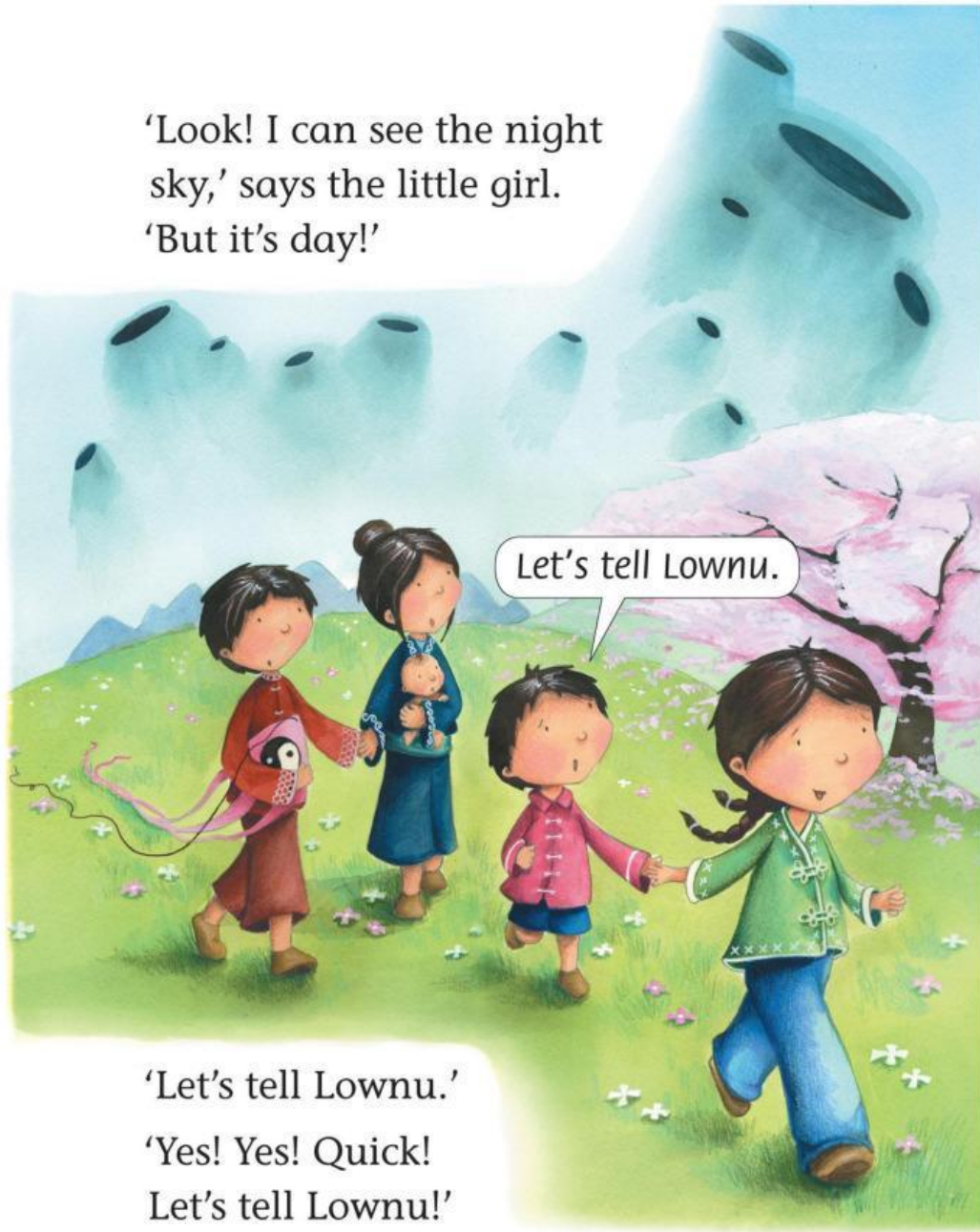
'Look!' says the little boy.
