

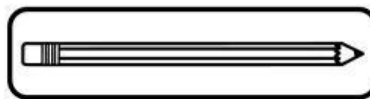

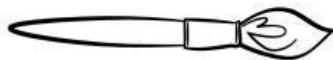
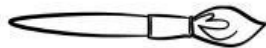
You can compare the lengths of objects.

Circle the longest pencil.

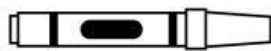


Make sure the pencils' ends are lined up to compare the lengths.

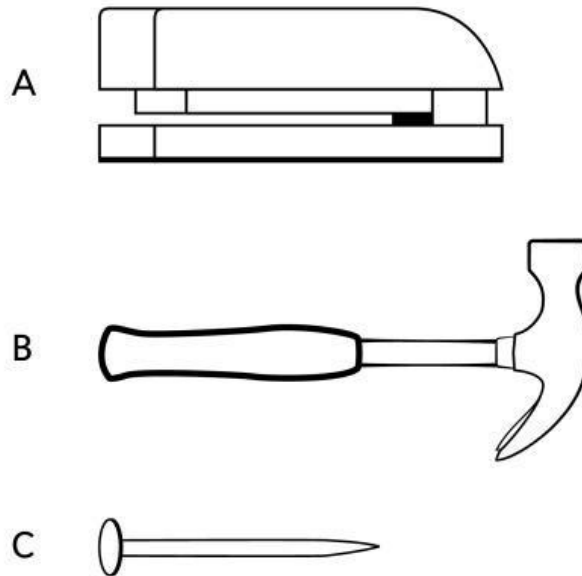
