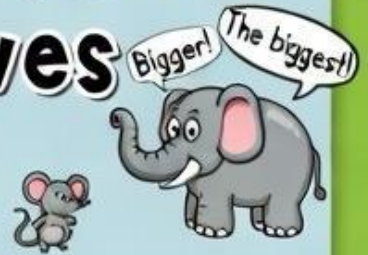

Quick Rules Reminder

One-syllable adjectives: add -er / -est	tall → taller → the tallest
Two+ syllables: use "more" / "the most"	beautiful → more beautiful → the most beautiful
Irregular forms:	good → better → best bad → worse → worst far → farther → the farthest
