Past perfect

Use	to talk about things that happened before an event in the past.
Affirmative	Had + P.P <i>When I woke up</i> , my mother <i>had prepared</i> breakfast
Negative	Hadn't + P.P He <i>hadn't washed</i> the car .
Question	Had + s + P.P <i>Had</i> he <i>washed</i> the car ?
Time words	When , before , after , because , by the time

Modals

Modal	Use	Form	Example
Must	To say we are sure of something	*In present: Must + inf *In the past Must + have +p.p	- he must be at school. - he must have been at school
Can't / couldn't	To say that we think something is impossible	*In present: Can't + inf *In the past couldn't + have +p.p	- you can't be serious - it couldn't have been a balloon.
May / might / could	To say that something is possible	*In present: May/might + inf *In the past Could/ might + have +p.p	- he might go to work. - he might have gone to work.
