



SIMPLE PRESENT WITH ROUTINES

USE

We use the simple present tense to talk about routines.



E.g., My mom makes breakfast every day. (It happens all week, from Monday to Sunday, repeatedly.)



STRUCTURE

Positive - Subject + main verb + complement.

He brushes his teeth.

Negative - Subject + don't/doesn't + main verb + complement.

They don't wake up early.

Question - Do/Does + subject + main verb + complement?

Does her sister have breakfast at 9h00?



BE CAREFUL!

When you use the third person (he, she, it), the main verbs change (E.g., they drink - she drinks), but for negatives and questions, we use the auxiliary doesn't and does for he, she, and it. (E.g., we don't understand - he doesn't understand).
