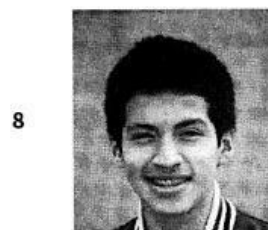
The young people below all want to find an art course to attend.
