

Possessive Nouns

Type	Rule	Example
Singular Nouns (one)	Noun + 's	The boy <u>s</u> toy is red.
Plural Nouns (ending in -s)	Noun + '	The boy <u>s'</u> toy is red.
Plural Nouns (NOT ending in -s)	Noun + 's	The children <u>s</u> toy is red.
