- A. In recent years, a new kind of book has become extremely popular with book lovers. More and more people are switching to audiobooks. These books have many benefits over traditional printed manuscripts. For example, you can listen to audiobooks and do other things if they don't need much of your attention. - D. World Book Day has been celebrated since 1995 on April 23. This day reminds people about the role of books in their lives. They come in different formats — printed, electronic, audio, etc. The first books appeared more than 2 thousand years ago. In the 15th century, the first printer appeared in Europe and printed books were published. It was a really revolutionary event in human history because the printer made books accessible to a wider audience of readers.

It improves their concentration, memory and some brain functions. While reading, people discover lots of ideas which can be used for their work and everyday life, and they learn to solve various problems. Besides, reading books reduces stress and makes people happier.
