	Present perfect Simple	Past simple
<b>Use</b>	-The exact time isn't known, or isn't important -Happened in the past until present (effect or event)	-The exact time is given -happened in the past , ended in the past
<b>Form</b>	Has/have + P.P I have worked on this project for a month	V2 I finished my project last week
<b>Negative</b>	He hasn't developed a new app.	He didn't study math last night.
<b>Question</b>	Has he developed a new app?	Did he study math last night?
<b>Key words</b>	For, since, yet, so far, ever, never, already, recently, lately, Just	Yesterday – last – ago

<b>For</b>	<b>Since</b>
To indicate the duration of the action	To indicate when the action began
Example: For two months, for a year , for a long time	Example: Since last year , since yesterday , since June
