Madagascar has many species of plants and animals that do not exist in other countries. Between 80 and 90 percent of its animals and plants have only ever been found in Madagascar.

People have lived in Madagascar for a very long time. Most researchers believe that the first people came to the island over 2000 years ago from Borneo in the South China Sea. Since then Arabs and East Africans, and later Indians, Chinese and Europeans have all lived in Madagascar. The population has risen to over 20 million people, causing many environmental problems.
