Mr Brown is talking to Anna about going to the city of Bristowe.

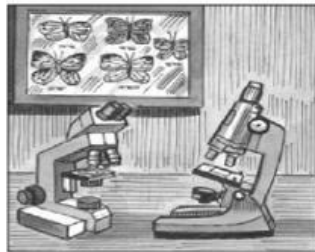

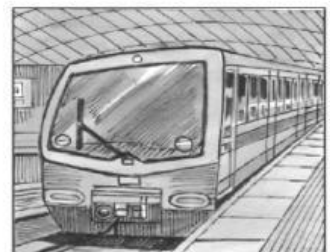

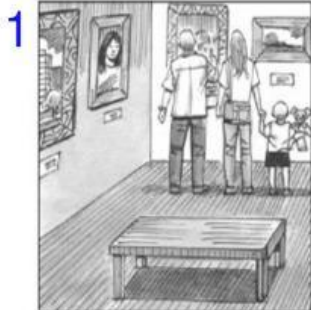
I have **(9)** to the small art gallery in our town many times, **(10)** this one in Bristowe was much better. I'd like to go again next year if I can.
