Type	Usage	Structure
Zero	General truths / Facts	If + Present Simple, ... Present Simple
First	Real possibilities	If + Present Simple, ... Will + Verb
Second	Hypothetical / Imaginary	If + Past Simple, ... Would + Verb
Third	Past regrets / Impossible	If + Past Perfect, ... Would have + Past Participle
