We use the Present Continuous to talk about actions that are happening right now, at this very moment.

+

Verb TO BE

Verb + -ING

How to use

Affirmative

Subject + am/is/are + verb-ing

I am eating an apple.

Negative

Subject + am/is/are + not + verb-ing

He is not (isn't) sleeping.

Question

Am/Is/Are + subject + verb-ing?

Are they playing football?
