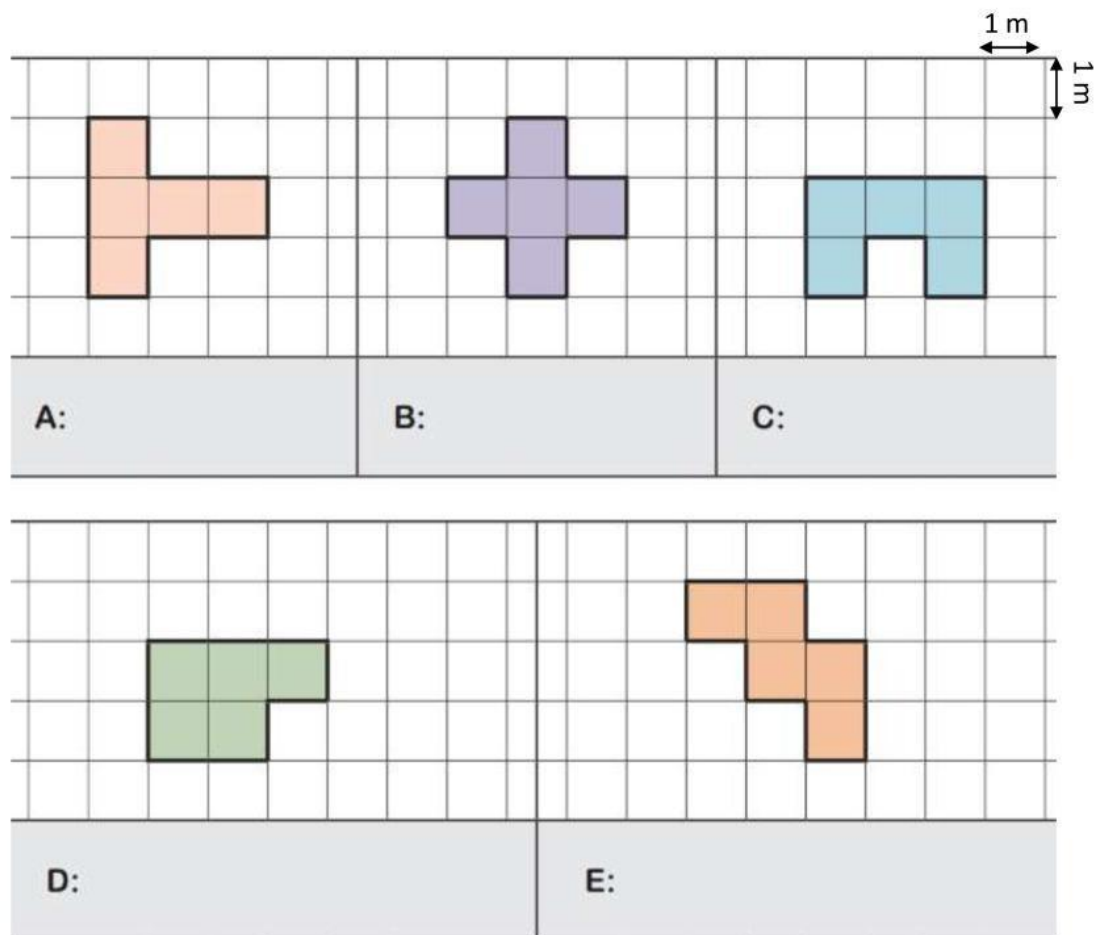

These figures are made up of 1-m squares.

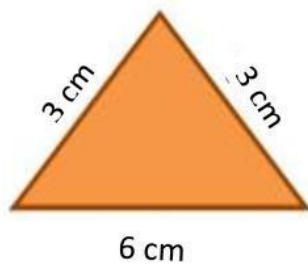
