- A. Any citizen of the country can freely visit the National Congress and other offices including the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. They only need to register before entering. Most buildings in the city have very large windows, glass passages and walls. The glass windows and facades of the President's residence and other government buildings symbolize the idea of transparent power. Actually, Brasilia looks very different in comparison to the previous capitals.
- B. Highways, railways and air routes connect Brasilia with the rest of the country. There are many international flights which are used not only by government staff but tourists and sports fans too. Brasilia is a well-known city of football as the World Cup was held there in 2014. In fact, apart from two professional soccer stadiums, Brasilia boasts its indoor arenas suitable for different sports, modern swimming pools and recreational zones for boating and fishing.
- C. Brasilia was officially opened in 1960. Actually, the construction of the new capital was completed in five years thanks to President Kubitschek. He officially announced the "fifty years in five" plan which he supported and controlled personally. A talented young architect, Niemeyer, realized his vision of an ideal city in the shape of a plane. The wings, the body and the cabin are formed by the most important government buildings and offices.
- D. Brasilia, the capital of the Federal Republic of Brazil, is one of the finest cities in the world. Two previous capitals, Salvador and Rio de Janeiro, were traditionally placed along the coast, which gave extra advantages to the coastal settlements at the expense of the other regions of the country. The new capital was built in the centre of the country, in a desert area. It was done to let all parts of the country develop in a balanced way.
- E. The president of the Federal Republic of Brazil considered the construction of the new capital a very important matter. In spite of that and in spite of Brasilia's general popularity, many politicians and staff were against moving there. They were used to the relaxing atmosphere, the beaches and facilities of Rio de Janeiro. They found the urban

design of the new capital boring and lifeless. Besides, there are no pavements in the city, so every resident has to drive a car or use a bus.

- F. The design of the new capital was based on the idea that the place would mainly be for government staff and civil servants. However, a lot of people came to Brasilia in search of a better life. At first they planned only to stay for the construction period, but they stayed there forever. As a result, instead of a population of five hundred thousand people that had been planned earlier, more than two million people live in Brasilia and its satellite towns today.
