→ *Comencé a ver la película a las ocho y todavía la estaba viendo a las diez.*

→ *Cuando el maestro entró al salón, los estudiantes estaban hablando fuerte.*
8. Were you sleeping last night while your sister **was studying** for her exam?
→ *¿Estabas durmiendo anoche mientras tu hermana estaba estudiando para su examen?*
