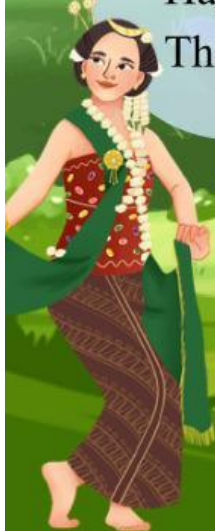

# CONCEPT EXPLANATION



## TIME CONNECTIVES

Time connectives help us tell events in **order**.  
They make our story **clear** and **organized**.

### Remember!

We use time connectives to show what happened first, next, and last.

### CONNECTIVES FOR THE BEGINNING

- First
- In the beginning
- At first

### CONNECTIVES FOR THE MIDDLE

- Then
- Next
- After that

### CONNECTIVES FOR THE END

- Finally
- At last
- In the end

### EXAMPLE PARAGRAPH

Last week, I went to an Independence Day parade in my hometown.

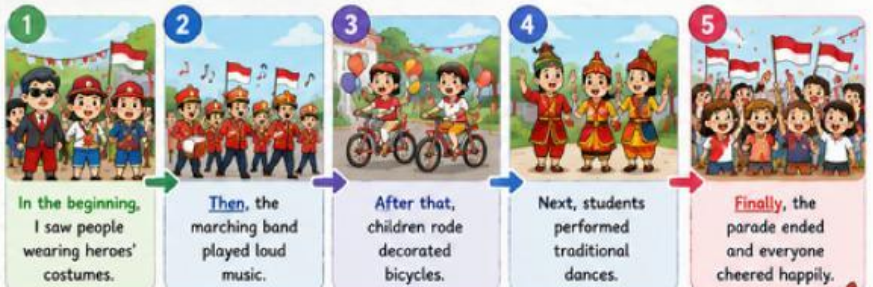
**In the beginning**, I saw people wearing heroes' costumes.

**Then**, the marching band played loud music.

**After that**, children rode decorated bicycles.

**Next**, students performed traditional dances.

**Finally**, the parade ended and everyone cheered happily.



Notice: The paragraph follows a **clear order**.
