<p><i>C. Prague</i></p> <p>Prague’s historic centre boasts beautiful architecture, museums, and charming cobbled streets. Entry fees and restaurant prices are generally moderate, making it popular with tourists who want culture without overspending. However, some areas can feel overcrowded, particularly in summer, which may affect the experience. Travellers willing to explore beyond the main tourist zones can discover quieter, scenic streets and local cafés that show the city’s authentic character.</p>	<p><i>D. Amsterdam</i></p> <p>Amsterdam is famous for its canals, cycling culture, and relaxed atmosphere. The city provides many cultural attractions, from museums to markets. While transport is efficient, many visitors prefer renting bikes to experience the city fully. Accommodation in central areas can be difficult to find during busy periods. Still, Amsterdam’s balance of leisure, culture, and accessible nature spots makes it an appealing destination for most tourists.</p>
