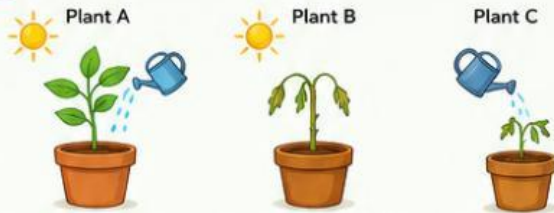

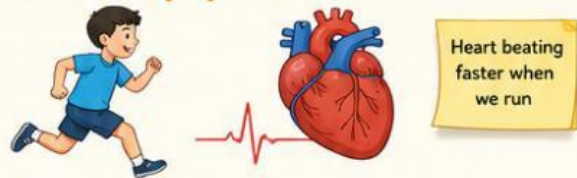

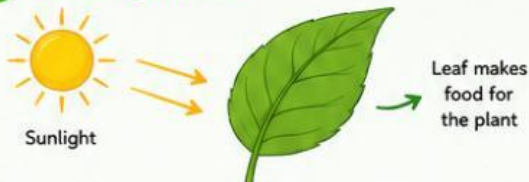

6 Plant Transport Experiment

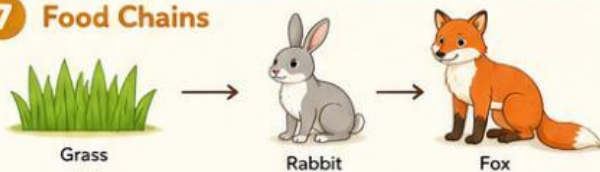


Experiment Description: A white flower stem was placed in blue-colored water. After one day, the petals turned blue.

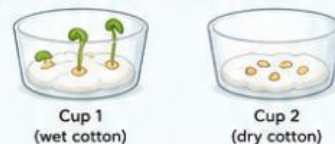
7 Food Chains
