If there is one animal that truly lives up to the saying "you are what you eat", it is probably the giant panda. What giant pandas eat affects many different parts of their lives.

Pandas can spend more than half of each day eating. This is because pandas mostly eat bamboo. Bamboo is a very poor source of nutrition for pandas. It is low in protein, high in fiber, and very difficult to digest. Since 99 percent of a panda's diet is bamboo, pandas need to eat a lot of it, 9 to 18 kilograms a day. Pandas also have tiny cubs because of their poor diet. Baby pandas are born blind, helpless, and tiny. They weigh just 140 grams, about one thousandth the size of their mother.

Pandas' black-and-white fur may help them camouflage in their environment. In winter, many animals lose their darker fur and grow white fur. However, since pandas are always moving around in search of bamboo, they can't change their fur quickly enough to match their background like other animals can. Therefore, being both black and white may help them hide in snow as well as among the dark leaves of the forest. In the past, pandas lived in and traveled across much larger areas of land and faced multiple predators, so they may have relied more on their black-and-white camouflage.

Today, the main threat to pandas is not from predators, but rather from a loss of bamboo. Human development has driven wild pandas into the mountains, away from their usual habitats and the bamboo they need. Climate change also threatens more than one third of the bamboo habitat that pandas depend on.
