Take a ride on a tram. A tram is a kind of electric bus that rides on metal tracks on the street. Amsterdam has a great tram system – I use it every day to get to work. I think the number 2 route is best for tourists. That's the tram that drives past many of the main Amsterdam sights, like the Van Gogh art gallery. The trams leave Amsterdam Central Station regularly, and tickets are not expensive. You can lock up your luggage in a locker so you don't have to carry it. And you won't be stressed about getting back to the airport in time — you can get off the tram at any stop and go back to the station on tram 2 in the opposite direction. It's perfect.
