Travel Advice

Many people enjoy going on holiday, but it can be difficult to choose where to go and what to do. Lisa works in a travel agency so we asked her to give us some advice.

How can people find a good place to stay?

In the past, this was quicker and easier because we didn't have the internet. There wasn't so much choice. Now, people can spend a lot of time looking at hotels and apartments online. In my opinion, you should ask other people like your friends for help. Or choose one website or app and just use that. There are other things to think about, not just your hotel, so don't spend too long choosing a place to stay.

What is the best way to travel for families?

I think going by car is better than taking a plane. Car journeys usually take longer than flying, but airports aren't good places for young children.
