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Parts of a Flower

What we call a flower is really the colorful top part of a plant. The delicate outer parts of a flower are called petals. Many petals together are called a blossom. Most flowers have colorful petals to attract insects or birds to pollinate the plant, which means to make a seed for a new plant. Flowers are designed for insects or birds and they can easily gather the pollen and carry it between the stamen and pistil. The stamen is usually a long thin tube on the flower and it gives off pollen. Pollen is a kind of sticky powder or syrup. The pistil looks like a thin tube or cup. A flower may have one or more pistils with an ovary. The ovary makes seeds.
