

COUNTABLE AND UNCOUNTABLE WORDS

Use countable nouns for things we can count. They have singular and plural forms.

Examples: *an apple – apples / a book – books*

Use uncountable nouns for things we cannot count. They do not have plural forms.

Examples: *water / information / furniture*
