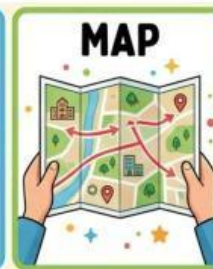
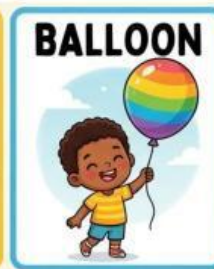
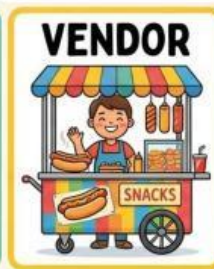
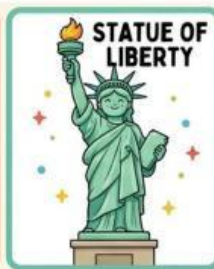
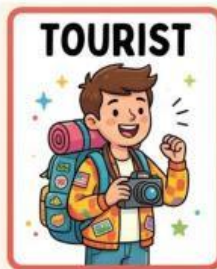
In New York City, people are enjoying their day in different ways.
