 - ↳ lay @ bottom4 days later (3)
- Even'g: C.C. → set sail fr. Italy (4)
 - ↳ lay partly @ coast of Italy later (5)

II. SIMILARITIES AND DIFFERENCES

1. Similarities

- Both T. & C.C. = ships (6)
 - + T: + 9 decks (7)
 - + C.C.: 951 feet long + (8)
 - Both: of their time (9)
- Both T. & C.C. = luxury ships w/,, variety of activities & places to relax (10)
- Acts of + acts of (11)
 - + T.: “..... & first” (12)
 - men on board gave up seats in to W & children (13)
 - someone acted like (14)
 - e.g.: M dressed as W → get into lifeboats & save (15)
 - + C.C.: “..... for himself” (16)
 - tripped in the dark & fell into lifeboat (17)
 - Italian ordered captain return to his ship, but he refused to go back (18)

2. Differences

	T.	C.C.
Captain	- w/ his ship (19)	- left his ship and (20)
Ship	- liner provided transportation across Atlantic Ocean (21) - sank in,, ocean waters (23)	- cruise ship provided vacation tours around (22) - sank in, water near coast (24)
Cause	- struck an (25)	- struck a near island off Italian coast (26)
# lives lost	- > 1,500 ppl died ← drowned or froze to death in icy water (27) - > survived (29)	- 32 ppl lost their lives + missing (28) - ≈ survived (30)
Reasons of death	- ships carried only to rescue all people (31) - most lifeboats: when they left T. (33)	- C. had extra lifeboats w/ room for > people than ship hold (32) - > lifeboats couldn't be lowered into water b/c ship lying (34)

III. REMINDER
