THE TWO-FINGER & ONE-FINGER RULE



FOR MORE THAN ONE person or thing (PLURAIL) + I / YOU

- I do my work.
- You do your chores.
- We do our best.
- They do their exercise.



I, YOU, WE, THEY
PLURAL NAMES
(e.g., Aiman & Siti)

DO



FOR ONE (SINGULAR)
PERSON OR THING
(not I or You)

- Hana does her art.
- The cat does its sleeping.
- Adam does his reading.

POSITIVE:

DO / DOES (YES!)

- You do know the answer.
- She does know how to swim.

NEGATIVE:

DON'T / DOESN'T (NO!)

- ✗ We don't go on Sundays. ✗
- ✗ He doesn't like spicy food.



! WATCH FOR THE DO/DOES SWAP! !

- ✗ You does know? ✗ vs. Do you know?
- ✗ He don't know. ✗ vs. He doesn't know.
