WE, THEY, YOU /
PLURAL NAMES
(e.g., Aiman & Siti)



ARE



FOR ONE (SINGULAR)
PERSON OR THING
(and for I with 'AM' (Special case))

- Hana **is** drawing.
- The cat **is** sleeping.
- Adam **is** ready for school.



POSITIVE:

IS / ARE (YES!)

- You **are** the winner.
- The flowers **are** beautiful.

NEGATIVE:

ISN'T / AREN'T (NO!)

- ✗ He **isn't** ready.
- ✗ The books **aren't** new.
