The "1-FINGER RULE"!
If it's just ONE, use IS/ISN'T.

→ Hana is writing.

→ The bird is in the nest.

→ Aisyah is smart.



HE, SHE, IT /
SINGULAR NAMES
(e.g., Adam, Siti)



IS / ISN'T

GREEN LIGHT:

IS (YES!)

→ It is sunny.

→ She is happy.

→ He is reading.

RED LIGHT:

ISN'T (NO!)

✗ It isn't raining.

✗ This isn't my book.

✗ He isn't sleeping.
