

Verb Rules for He / She / It

Rule	How to change	Examples
1. Most Verbs	Add -s	walk → walk <u>s</u> play → play <u>s</u>
2. Ending in <u>-ch, -sh, -s, -x, -o</u>	Add -es	watch → watch <u>es</u> wash → wash <u>es</u> kiss → kiss <u>es</u> mix → mix <u>es</u> go → go <u>es</u>
3. Ending in <u>Consonant + y</u>	Drop -y, add -ies	fly → flie <u>s</u> study → studi <u>es</u>
