

Present Continuous (1)

Subject + BE Verb (am / is / are) + Verb-ing

Rule	How to change	Examples
1. Most Verbs	Add -ing	walk → walk <u>ing</u> play → play <u>ing</u>
2. Ending in <u>-e</u>	Drop -e, add -ing	write → writ <u>ing</u> dance → danc <u>ing</u>
3. Ending in <u>1 vowel + 1 consonant</u>	Double final consonant, add -ing	run → run <u>ning</u> swim → swim <u>ming</u>
