Choose the right tense to express actions.

PRESENT CONTINUOUS



We use it for actions happening **now** or around now. We also use it for temporary situations.

Form: **am/is/are + verb-ing**

Examples:

- I **am studying** for my exam this week.
- She **is working** on a research project.

VS.

SIMPLE PRESENT



We use it for habits, routines and general truths. We also use it for permanent situations.

Form: **base form (he/she/it + s/es)**

Examples:

- I **study** English every day.
- Water **boils** at 100°C.
