We use the Present Perfect for actions **completed recently** or **experiences**.

| POSITIVE                                   | NEGATIVE                                      | QUESTION                                   |
|--------------------------------------------|-----------------------------------------------|--------------------------------------------|
| I / You / We / They<br><b>have</b> played. | I / You / We / They<br><b>haven't</b> played. | <b>Have</b> I / you / we / they<br>played? |
| He / She / It<br><b>has</b> played.        | He / She / It<br><b>hasn't</b> played.        | <b>Has</b> he / she / it<br>played?        |
