

# Reading Passage: Jack the Ripper

In the autumn of 1888, fear spread through the streets of London's Whitechapel district. A mysterious killer, later known as Jack the Ripper, murdered several women in the area. The crimes shocked the public because they were extremely violent, and the police could not find the murderer. Even today, more than one hundred years later, the identity of Jack the Ripper remains unknown.

Most historians believe that Jack the Ripper killed at least five women between August and November 1888. The victims were poor women who worked and lived in difficult conditions. The killer attacked them late at night in dark streets or narrow alleys. Newspapers reported every detail of the murders, and many people became frightened to walk outside after sunset.
