

## GRAMMAR – Comparing People

### Grammar Box: Key Structures for Describing and Comparing People

Structure	Use	Example
<b>look like + noun</b>	Physical appearance	<i>She looks like her sister.</i>
<b>be like + noun</b>	Personality / character	<i>She is like a ray of sunshine.</i>
<b>look alike / act alike</b>	Shared look/behavior	<i>They look alike but don't act alike.</i>
<b>much/far + comparative</b>	Big difference	<i>She is much nicer than Evelana.</i>
<b>a little/slightly comparative</b> +	Small difference	<i>He is slightly taller than me.</i>
<b>just as + adj + as</b>	Equal comparison	<i>She is just as tall as Anna.</i>
<b>not as + adj + as</b>	Unequal comparison	<i>Evelana is not as friendly as Anna.</i>
