The power company will reduce energy supplied to electric devices at times of high demand such as during cold winter days when heating systems run often, or during stuffy summer afternoon when air-conditioners work at most. In most cases, the power company controls the power with radio signals. During periods of high electricity demand, a radio signal activates the switch to turn off certain devices. When electricity demand goes down, a second signal returns the devices to normal operation. In exchange for the power company to control their systems, customers receive electric rate about half the price of the standard one.
