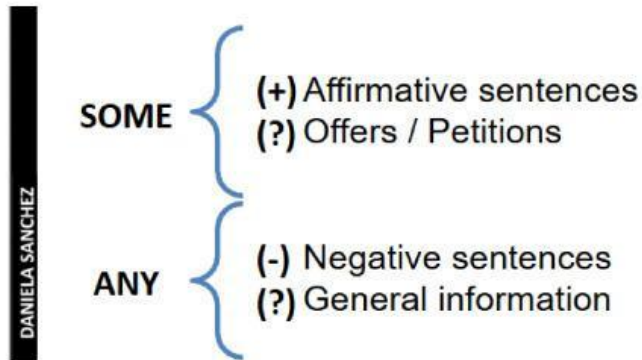


Cooking for mom
